Required supporting documents for applications for study commencing 2020

Document requirements

Applicants must submit all supporting documents with their application—these include generic documents specified in the Scholarships Policy Handbook and country-specific for India.

Documents requiring certification are specified in the table. If the document is not in English, the translated copy must be certified. See the Scholarships Policy Handbook for certification requirements.
